

Objective:

In this project you are to take a movie and make a parody of it. Think “Lady and the Trampoline” or “Fatman” – the sillier the better.

To begin take any image from a movie; a movie poster, a movie’s DVD cover, or ad for a movie and through Photoshop turn it into a new movie which parodies the original.

Have fun, keep it clean, and be creative. Don’t forget the clichés! As always, quality is a must. Try to use the highest resolution files you can get your hands on.

www.whatthefont.com may prove to be a good resource for this project. It will help you identify fonts so that you can more easily reshape the original.

You will do this twice over creating two different Comps.

This project will test your creativity as well as your Photoshop problem solving capabilities. I am here to help you – just ask.

Work Professionally. Remember to use Layer Masks and work non-destructively when possible . . . And name you layers too!

Submitting:

1. Name your un-flattened PSD working files with Proj_3_ then your first initial than underscore then your last name, then an underscore and a sequence number. It should look similar to this:

Proj_3_J_Ramirez_1.psd

Proj_3_J_Ramirez_2.psd

2. Submit your properly named un-flattened PSD file to BlackBoard before the assignments expiration date.

You will also be submitting your PSDs to the server. I will direct you on how to do this.

Creativity is paramount. Use the appropriate tools in Photoshop that your project requires and as always work nondestructively. Please ask any questions for clarification. If you are confused about anything it is generally better to ask than to guess, that is unless you are afraid of the answer – but in that case you already know the answer, so you wouldn’t have to ask in the first place.
