

**Objective:**

Your objective is to create two images both from the same parallel world – a world much like our own, but with subtle changes.

What would the world be like if we never progressed from steam powered machines? What would our world look like if the Founding Fathers of the United States were all females? How would our world differ if we were all color blind?

This project is a test of your creativity. Create two images from a parallel world. The two images you create should be from the same parallel world. You may choose to start with everyday items and then tweak them as if they developed through a different course of evolution, or you may choose to take a different course all together. You may photograph your starting images or find hi-res images online. There are no specific Photoshop techniques you should use, but you should always work non-destructively when possible. Again this project is a test of both your imagination and of the Photoshop techniques you are able to recall.

**Submitting:**

1. Name your un-flattened PSD working files with Proj\_1\_ then your first initial than underscore then your last name, then an underscore and a sequence number. It should look similar to this:

Proj\_1\_J\_Ramirez\_1.psd

Proj\_1\_J\_Ramirez\_2.psd

2. Submit your properly named un-flattened PSD files to BlackBoard before the assignments expiration date.

Creativity is paramount. Work nondestructively. You may find that you may need to do your own photography. Please ask any questions for clarification. If you are confused about anything it is generally better to ask than to guess, that is unless you are afraid of the answer – but in that case you already know the answer, so you wouldn't have to ask in the first place.

You will have two weeks to complete this project. Late projects will drop a full grade (an A will become a B). Projects are absolutely due by the end of class on the last day of classes before finals week.
